

# SITI Company Residency Rider

## The Residency Host will provide the following:

### Workshop Requirements:

-A well lit rehearsal studio or black box theater with minimum dimensions of 30' x 35' (obviously, larger is better). A wooden floor, preferably sprung with a Marley surface. If Marley is not available, the surface of the floor needs to be smooth and safe for bare feet. It can be a theater stage, dance studio or rehearsal room with a good floor. A clear open space with a limited amount of furniture is required for the training.

-A studio with no mirrors on the wall is preferable or if a mirrored room, please cover.

-Studio should have adequate heating or air conditioning depending on weather.

-Training studio should be properly swept and mopped prior to each training session.

-A sound system with a pair of powered speakers, a small Mackie and a CD player which hooks into it is preferred. If the space allows we can get by with a boom-box that should have no smaller than 5 inch drivers.

-20 to 25 students maximum in each class depending on size of space. A larger amount of students is negotiable well in advance of the workshop.

-Prior knowledge of SITI Company's training and performances is necessary for the students to provide them with a context. This enables SITI Company teachers to maximize the short time they have with the students and assists them with approaching the training from a focused mind set.

-Students should be advised that the classes demand physical agility and endurance. Some conditioning prior to the workshop is recommended. They should come to class dressed to move (no jeans, dresses or skirts – shorts, tights and leggings are necessary). Suzuki students will be required to wear socks during class and should wear clothing that shows the contours of the legs and upper body (ie, no baggy sweats). Viewpoints classes will be conducted in bare feet. Classes will begin promptly.

-SITI Company instructor should have access to the space prior to the commencement of the first workshop.

-Residency representative at each class to deal with logistics.

-Video and or photography of workshop is by mutual agreement. If agreed, an archival copy of recorded material or photographs is requested for the SITI Company archive.

-Question and Answer session after workshop can be arranged by mutual agreement.

-It is necessary that all note taking is done after the class session has ended.

-Prior communication regarding possible observers of the workshop should happen well in advance. Observers will only be allowed by mutual agreement.

### Hospitality Requirements:

-If the training studio is not within walking distance (1/4 mile) from the hotel, or in bad weather conditions, or late nights, transportation to and from the studio should be provided (either via rental car or shuttle service).

-Transportation to and from the airport or train station should also be provided. Details regarding who will be providing transportation and where SITI Company will be met should be communicated well in advance.

-A filtered water source should be nearby for Company and workshop participants to fill their own personal water bottles as the classes are physically demanding and require hydration on a regular basis.

-Upon arrival, SITI should receive detailed maps of the area, suggested restaurants, round-trip directions from studio to hotel, etcetera.

-If residency host has access to a university gym or affiliation with a gym facility, a gym pass for SITI instructors is requested for the duration of their stay.
